

#### Motion 1

That all existing references to the “Senior National Championship” be revised to read “Senior National Championship Regatta”. The same modification should be applied to Junior National Championship, all references separately and jointly should be referred to (designation) National Championship Regatta.

#### Motion 2

The current statement written:

In case of a tie, for a prize winning position in the regatta, the yacht defeating the other yacht(s) involved the greatest number of times, over the entire series (including throwouts), shall be declared the winner. If a tie still exists, the yacht defeating the other(s) in the final race (including throwouts) shall be declared the winner. If a tie still exists, duplicate prizes shall be awarded

Be deleted and replaced with:

In case of a tie, the US Sailing tie breaking system as defined in RRS Appendix A8 will be used

#### Motion 3

The current statement written:

“Two throwout races are allowed if twelve (12) nine (9) completed races are sailed.”

Should be deleted and replaced with:

“One throwout race will be allowed for every six (6) races sailed.

#### Motion 4

The section specific to Junior eligibility be written:

Skippers and crews in the Junior National Championship Regatta shall not have reached their 19th birthday by the end of the calendar year of the competition.

#### Motion 5

The section labeled “General” be written:

General - The Junior and Senior National Championship Regattas shall be sanctioned regattas and thereby governed by the Association By-Laws. All instructions and regulations not fully described in the Association By-Laws or in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) of the United States Sailing Association *US Sailing Racing Rules* shall be published in the Race Sailing Instructions. Rule 87 of the RRS will not apply to AYPYRA.

#### Motion 6

The Article 20 section labeled “Substitutions” be deleted from article 20. (it repeats a portion on article 19)
