

# 2016 INDY OUTTY Y-FLYER REGATTA

## NOTICE OF RACE

**ORGANIZING AUTHORITY:** The 2016 Indy Outty Regatta is organized by Y-Flyer Fleet 8 at the Indianapolis Sailing Club.

**RULES:** This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the By-Laws of AYFYRA. This is a Category A event. This regatta will be combined with the Old Oaken Rudder Regatta competed between the sailing teams of Indiana and Purdue Universities.

**ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY:** This regatta is open to all who sail a Y-Flyer sailboat.

**FEES:** Registration fees are \$60.00 per boat. This includes meals and snacks for skipper and crew Saturday morning through Sunday noon. A discount of \$5.00 is allowed if the skipper is a current member of US Sailing. Additional Steak dinners on Saturday after sailing are \$10.00 each.

**SCORING:** The Low Point System as described in Appendix A to AYFYRA Class By-Laws shall be used except that in the event of a score tie, the skipper who beat the other the most times is declared the better skipper. All races sailed shall be scored. One completed race shall constitute the regatta.

**PRIZES:** Trophies for skipper and crew shall be awarded for the first five places.
